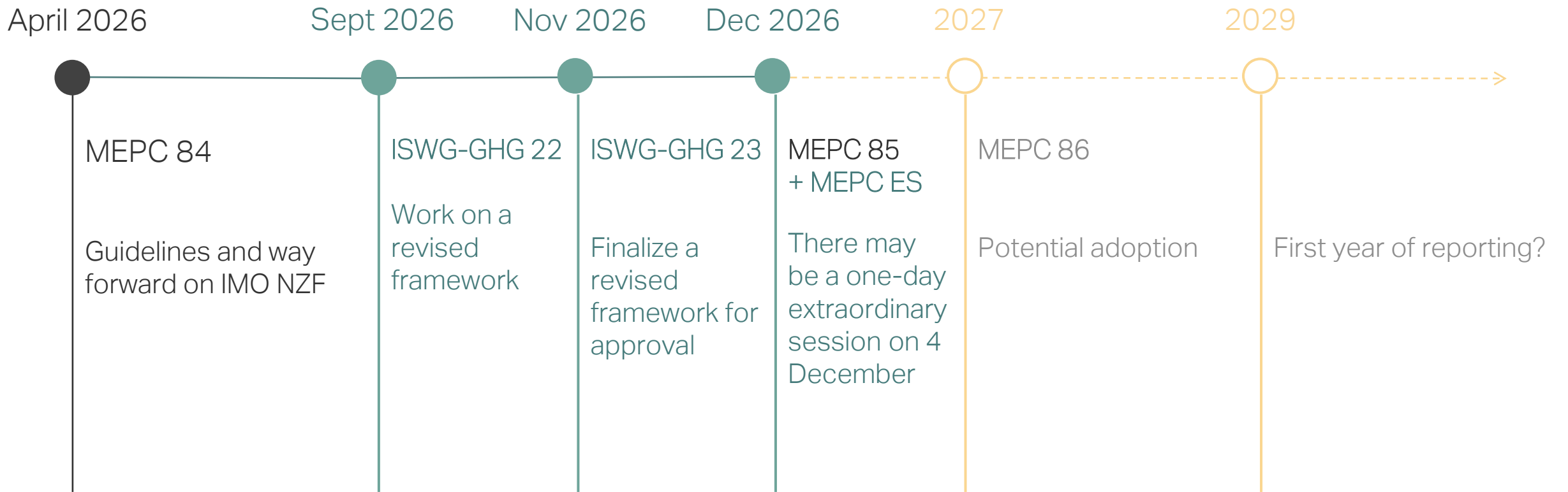

Potential future timeline

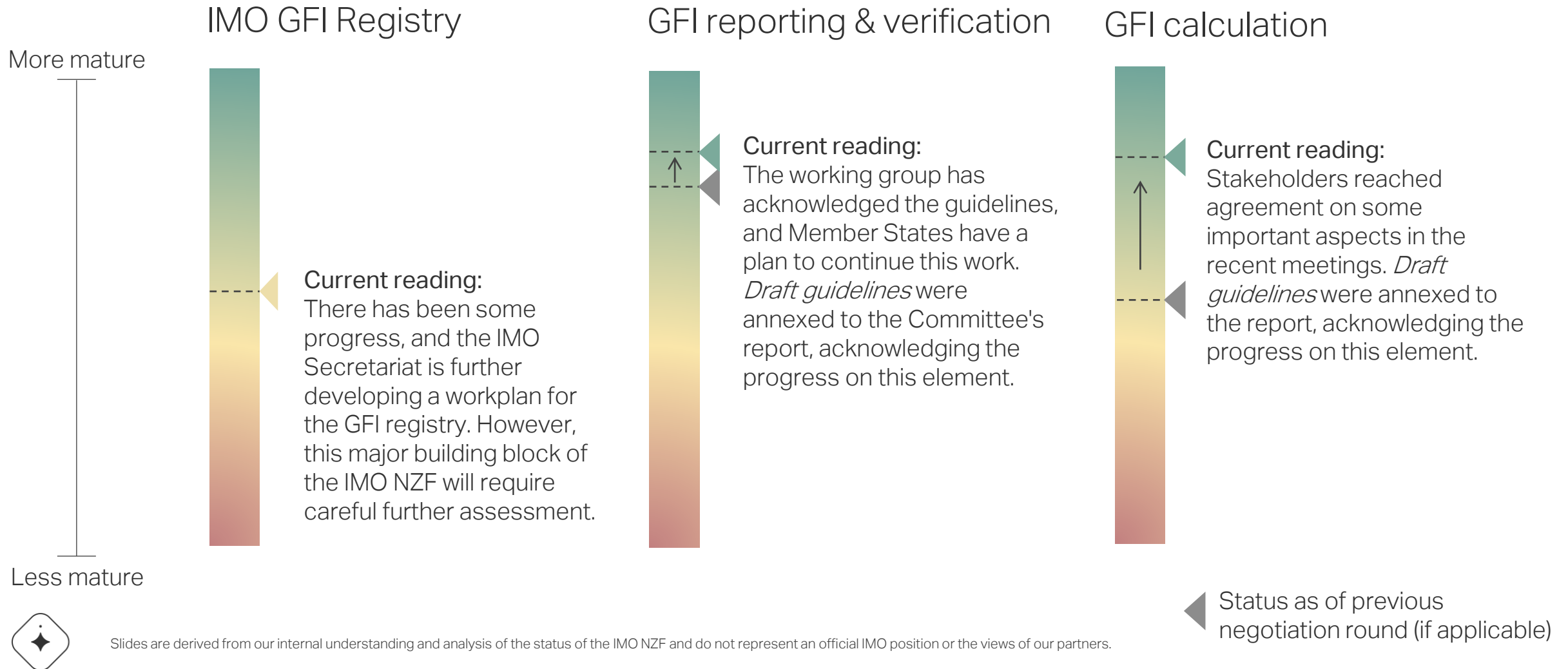

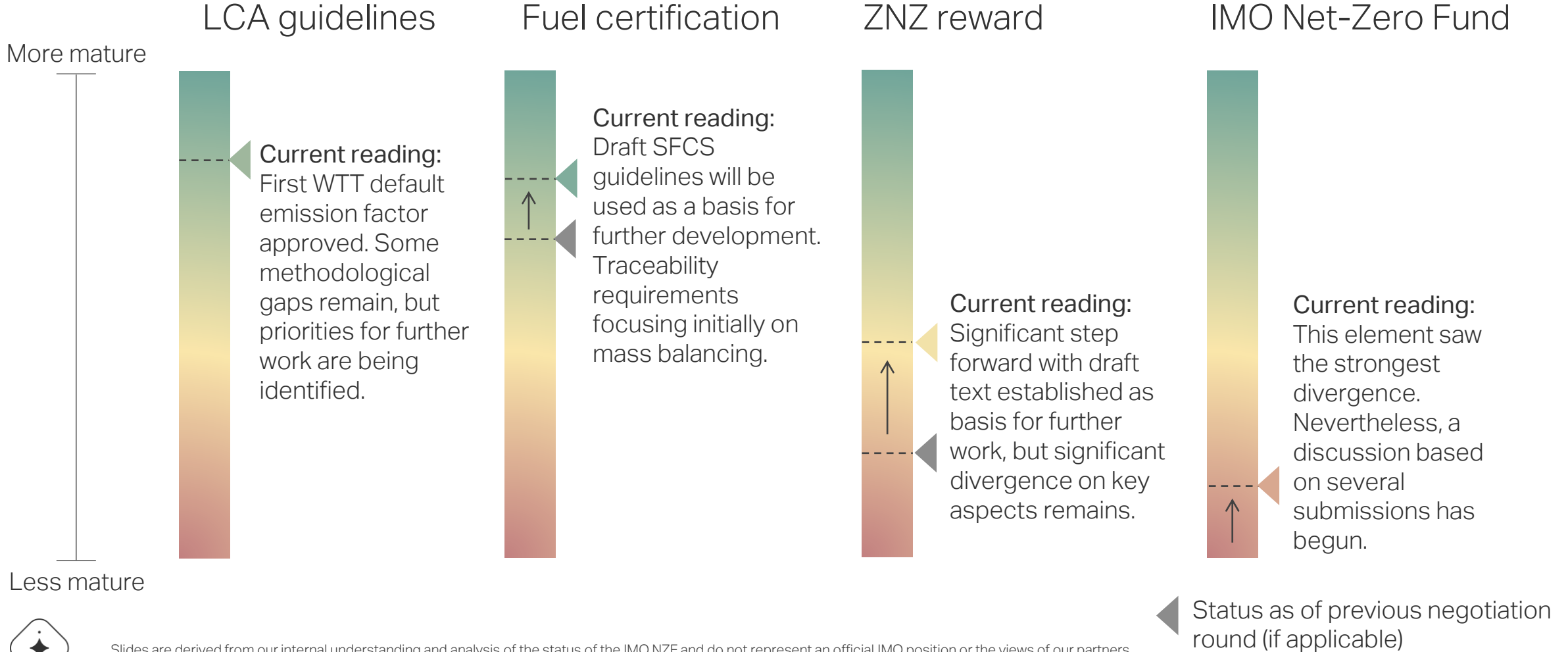

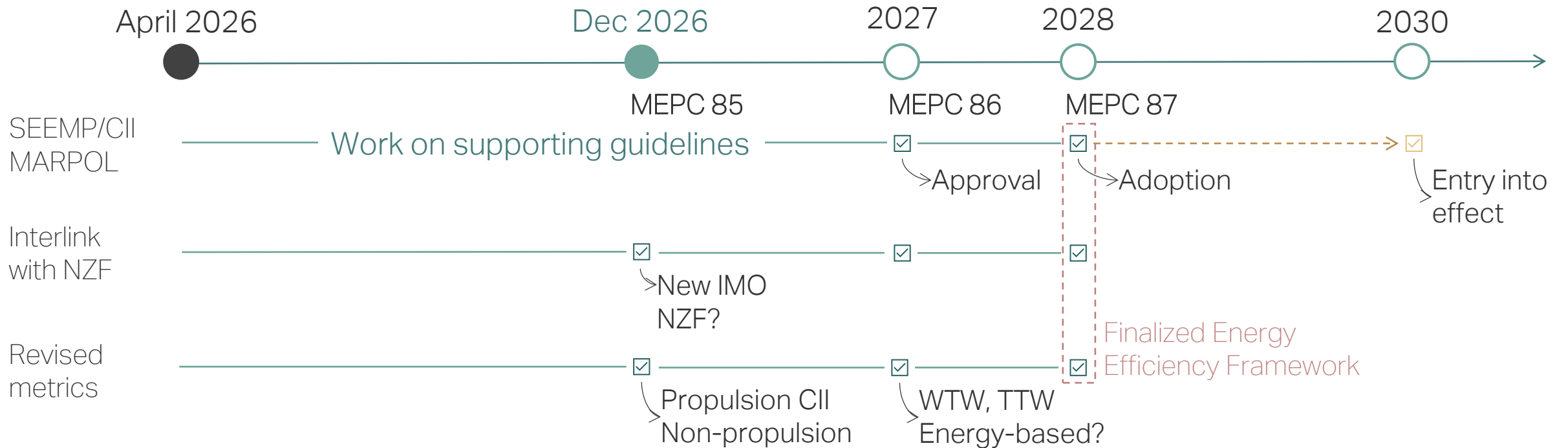
